2. COMPOSITION/INFORMATION ON INGREDIENTS

PRODUCT IDENTIFICATION / PHYSICAL DATA

Sterilised Bone Meal ground to requirements, used as a source of organic Nitrogen and Phosphorus. Buff – brown powder. Typical sizes 0 – 3 mm. Insoluble in water.

CHEMICAL PROPERTIES

Stable under normal storage and handling conditions.

3. FIRE FIGHTING MEASURES

FIRE

Not in itself combustible, but in intense heat may release toxic fumes. Wear suitable self contained breathing apparatus. Contain contaminated run-off.

EXPLOSIVE BEHAVIOUR

Not applicable

4. FIRST AID MEASURES

INHALATION:	Wear dust respirator. Dust has low toxicity but may form deposits in nose and respiratory tracts. Occupational Exposure Standards have been established for atmospheric dust – see HSE Notes EH40.
SKIN:	Prolonged exposure may result in some irritation. Wear gloves or wash exposed skin thoroughly after use.
EYES:	Wear goggles. May cause irritation on contact. Irrigate eyes with water thoroughly for 15 minutes. Obtain medical advice if symptoms persist.
INGESTION:	Do not eat, drink or smoke while using product. Unlikely that sufficient could be accidentally ingested to cause hazard. Small quantities not harmful. If in doubt obtain medical advice.



5. HANDLING AND STORAGE

Locate away from sources of heat, fire and explosion. Store under cover, in original containers in a secure and well ventilated cool dry area. Store clear of foodstuffs and in a separate stack from herbicides. Keep away from children.

6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

SPILL PROCEDURE: Spillages are collected and used for its purposes if possible. Sweep up gently to avoid raising dust and place in suitable marked container. Contaminated material can be disposed of in an approved land fill, in accordance with local regulations depending on type and extent of contamination. Do not put in drains, sewers or watercourses.

7. STABILITY AND REACTIVITY

Bone Meal is stable. Ensure free of contaminants.
